

The Evangelical church in Femme Osage was founded in 1833, as the first German Evangelical Church west of the Mississippi River. Founding pastor, the Rev. Dr. Hermann Garlich would

pioneer six other local congregations, begin a Christian school, and establish a seminary (which would eventually become Eden Seminary). The current congregation just celebrated its 190<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of faithfulness to the Lord Jesus Christ and its commitment to the Great Commission.



# **DIRECTIONS**

From the North (Foristell) via I-70: Exit I-70 at Foristell and take Highway T south (approximately 12.5 miles). At the intersection of County Road TT, stay on Highway T (the road curves to the left (east)) and follow it approximately 1.25 miles. You will enter the Femme Osage Creek valley and you will see the village of Femme Osage on your left (north). Turn left on Cappeln-Osage Road to enter the Village of Femme Osage. The church is on the right (east).

From the South (Washington) via Highway 47: Take Highway 47 North from Washington and exit right (north) onto Hwy TT into Dutzow. Follow Hwy TT north until it dead ends at Hwy T. Turn right (east) and follow it approximately 1.25 miles. You will enter the Femme Osage Creek valley and you will see the village of Femme Osage on your left (north). Turn left on Cappeln-Osage Road to enter the Village of Femme Osage. The church is on the right (east).

From the East (St. Louis) via I-44: Take I-44 West to State Highway 100 (the Washington exit) and exit right (north). Follow Hwy 100 into Washington. At the intersection of Hwy 100 and Hwy 47 (landmark: Walgreens in NW corner) turn right (north) and follow Hwy 47 (past Mercy Hospital, over the bridge, and into the country. You will pass an airport on your right). At the stop light, turn right (north) onto Hwy TT to Dutzow. Follow Hwy TT north until it dead ends at Hwy T. Turn right (east) and follow it approximately 1.25 miles. You will enter the Femme Osage Creek valley and you will see the village of Femme Osage on your left (north). Turn left onto Cappeln-Osage Road to enter the Village of Femme Osage. The church is on the right (east).

From the West (Kansas City) via I-70: Same instruction as "From the North (Foristell)" above.
