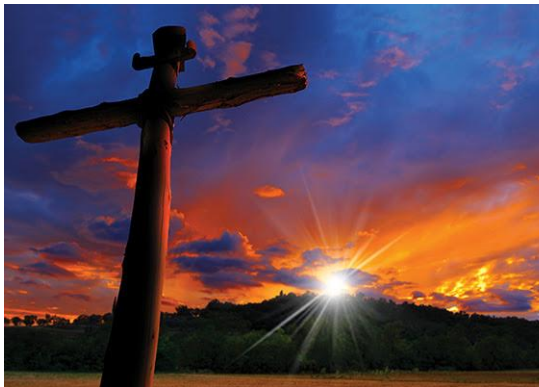




About Us

Study Paths

Mount Carmel Academy offers three paths of study:

Ordination

This is a three-year required course of study leading toward Ordination into the pastoral ministry in a local church. This path is recommended for anyone seeking pastoral ministry.
